Terms of participation

«SPETSATHLON»

1. Necessary conditions for participation

A. Each participant must have reached the age of 18, with the exception of participation in the 1,000m swimming event, where persons over the age of 12 years old are allowed to participate in (before 10th May 2006), as well as in the Spetsathlon Triathlon Sprint for people over 15 years old (prior to 10.5.2003).

B. If a minor wants to participate in the above-mentioned events, the minor participant must have obtained the consent of his/her custodian. In order to prove the required consensus, a responsible declaration of the parent / guardian must be presented, in full compliance with the "PARENTAL DECLARATION OF PARENT" standard, which is posted on the website of the competition. In order to prove the minor's racing competence, a responsible statement from the coach of the minor participant shall be presented, in full compliance with the "RESPONSIBLE STATEMENT OF TRAINER" template posted on the website of the competition.

C. For the participation in the events it is necessary for the participants to wear the timing chip, whereas for the athletes of use of a cycling race helmet is NECESSARY!

D. You are allowed to participate in the events with relay teams.

E. Each participant has to pay the respective participation fee within three days of its online registration. The participation fee is paid through a bank deposit to the following account and the name of the participant and / or the registration number and the e-mail received at the time of registration.

4. Disclaimer of organizer's responsibility

All athletes are responsible for their fitness and must be examined by a physician prior to the event to determine their ability to participate in a match. In addition, they have to be insured in the event of an accident during their participation in a match. Participants are aware of the potential risk of bodily harm or damage to their equipment from their participation in the event and the consequences thereof. The organizer is not responsible for the death, injury or any damage to the health of the participants who, by submitting the application, declare that they are aware of the risks involved in the match, have the relevant experience, are insured in the event of an accident the duration of their participation and

that their state of health is good and allows them to fight. With their application to the race they declare that they will not, in any case, turn to or demand a claim against the organizers or their representatives or sponsors or supervisor if they suffer material, physical or moral harm themselves or their escorts or any third party their registration or participation in the match. In his / her application, the participant confirms that he / she has been informed and checked the safety measures and declared compliance with the relevant safety rules of the event that have been demonstrated to him / her. By submitting the application, the participant waives the right to pursue any legal action or any other remedy concerning possible disputes or issues with regard to his/her participation and the conduct of the race.
